

Dear Parents,

Happy Lent to all. During this beautiful season, we teach the children daily about how much Jesus loves us. We encourage them to have their hearts filled with the love of Jesus and act as He would in kindness and love for all. As we travel through this season of renewal, the children can earn Purple Giving Crosses. At home or at school, if a child shows an act of kindness, they earn a Purple Giving Cross. There is a large, white cross in the preschool hallway. Our goal is to turn the white cross PURPLE with all the children's Purple Giving Crosses. The children can earn the Purple Giving Crosses beginning on March 5th – Ash Wednesday through April 16th. We sent a letter home explaining this activity. If you need more Purple Giving Crosses, let your child's teacher know.

In class, the children will learn the journey of Jesus to the cross and why He did this for us. Each class has a Crown of Thorns with forty toothpicks. Each day, the class will remove one toothpick and discuss this special journey. This amazing story of Jesus is also told with beautiful pictures of the Stations of the Cross, visiting the Stations in the Garden and Church and Resurrection Eggs. It is a privilege to share this story with your children.

We will celebrate our Holy Heroes – St. Patrick and St. Joseph in March also. A special story of the "Fava Bean" in honor of St. Patrick will be sent home with the children. We will have a St. Joseph table set up in the library that will have many symbols and items about Jesus' earthly Father – St. Joseph.

In February Bible time, the children learned about the importance of prayer time – talking with Jesus at any time. They are learning prayer hands, pointing up to heaven, next to their hearts because Jesus lives in their hearts. Each child received a very special "Prayer Rock" to help them remember to pray every morning and night. God LOVES to talk with our littles!





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

Help Your Child Grow and Thrive by Monitoring Their Development!

Developmental Milestones are skills such as taking a first step, smiling for the first time, and waving "bye-bye." Tracking these important milestones can help you see if your child's development is on track, or if they need extra support and intervention. Choose your child's age below to view expected developmental milestones for children of that age. You can also compare expected milestones between age groups by choosing up to three ages. Each age group lists milestones to look for in four different developmental domains. If your child's age is between checklists, use the younger checklist.





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
